

**Language Arts (Adverb):**

Adverbs are mostly used with verbs. They add additional meaning to the verb by telling how, when, where or to what extent it happens. An adverb can make a verb much stronger.

Examples: Donald quickly eats all his fries.

The verb in this sentence is eats, and the adverb **quickly** modifies the verb. Without the adverb, we would not know how Donald eats the fries.
