1. **Scare** (verb): To frighten; to become filled with fear

Similar word(s): frighten

Sentence: Little John is scared of dogs.

2. **Scatter** (verb): To cause to separate in all directions

Similar word(s): distribute, separate

Sentence: My dad scatters wheat grains for birds to eat.

3. **Sincere** (adjective): Showing honest feeling; real

Similar word(s): honest, true

Sentence: The principal has sincere interest to improve the quality of education in the school.

4. **Snap** (verb): To break quickly with a cracking sound

Similar word(s): pop, break

Sentence: The moment I stepped on the tree branch, it snapped.

5. **Triumph** (noun): A great success or victory

Similar word(s): success, victory

Sentence: Winning state championship was a triumph for the team.
